1st Steps Waltz

4 WALL - 36 COUNTS - IMPROVER			
STEPS	Actual Footwork	Calling Suggestion	DIRECTION
Section 1	Weave Right, Full Turn		
1 - 3	Cross left over right. Step right to right side. Cross left behind right.	Cross Side Behind	Right
4 - 6	Make full turn right, stepping - right, left, right.	Turn 2 3	Turning right
Option	Replace full turn with right coaster step; or triple step in place 1, 2, 3		
Section 2	Grapevine Left, Full Turn		
1 - 3	Step left to left side. Cross right behind left. Step left to left side.	Side Behind Side	Left
4 - 6	Make full turn left, stepping - right, left, right.	Turn 2 3	Turning left
Option	Replace full turn with right coaster step; or triple step in place 1, 2, 3		
Section 3	Basic Forward, Back Lock Step		
1 - 3	Step left forward. Step right beside left. Step left beside right.	Step 2 3	Forward
4 - 6	Step right back. Lock left across right. Step right back.	Right Lock Back	Back
Section 4	Back Lock Step, Coaster Step		
1 - 3	Step left back. Lock right across left. Step left back.	Left Lock Back	Back
4 - 6	Step right back. Step left beside right. Step right forward.	Coaster Step	On the spot
Section 5	Step, Kick, Coaster Step		
1 - 3	Step left forward. Kick right forward (2 counts).	Step Kick	Forward
4 - 6	Step right back. Step left beside right. Step right forward.	Coaster Step	On the spot
Section 6	Step, Kick, Sailor 1/4 Turn		
1 - 3	Step left forward. Kick right forward (2 counts).	Step Kick	Forward
4 - 6	Sweep right behind left making 1/4 turn right. Step left to side. Step right to place.	Sailor Turn	Turning right
Ending	On last wall, bring the turn around to the front wall.
