#### Start on the vocals

1-3 4-6	Waltz basic forward, twinkle step Left stride forward; right step forward; left step forward Right crossover; left together; right step in place
1-3 4-6	Twinkle-turn, coaster step Left crossover; right step side turning ½ left; left step back (9:00) Right step back; left together; right step forward
1-3 4-6	Stride forward, pivot turn ¼ left, crossover, toe touch side, hold Left stride forward; right step forward; pivot turn ¼ left (6:00) Right crossover; left toe point side; hold **

### Crossover, toe touch side, hold, crossover, step side turning 1/4 right, step side

- 1-3 Left crossover; right toe point side; hold
- 4-6 Right crossover; left step side turning ¼ right; right step side \*\*\*\* (9:00)

(Can be done as a split floor with the Improver version "Sparkle & Shine". "Improver" dancers will be doing the same 24 steps at the 12:00 and 6:00 walls as the Beginners)
